

DESCRIPTION

The tour starts, accompanied by our official guide, from Plaza Nueva, heading on foot towards the Cathedral of Seville. On the way we will see the monument to Ferdinand III. A majestic bronze statue of the monarch on horseback. On one side of the square is the Renaissance-style Seville Town Hall. Continuing along the route, we will walk along the Avenida de la Constitución, one of the most important streets in the city of Seville. The main entrance to the Cathedral is located here. Once inside, we will be able to observe its Gothic style, the High Altarpiece, its Trasaltar, the different chapels, its works of art and its altars. Then we will access La Giralda, the bell tower of the cathedral. It is 104 metres high. From here you will have the best views of the city of Seville. It was built under Moorish influence, but the top and bell tower is from the Christian Renaissance period. Continuing with the tour, we head towards the Alcazar. Next to the Cathedral is the Archive of the Indies, famous for being the building where all the documentation concerning the Americas was managed. Together with the Alcazar and the Cathedral it is also a World Heritage Site. Our guide will explain the history behind these wonderful and illustrious monuments. We will continue with a visit to the Reales Alcazares of Seville, an undoubted symbol of the union of Gothic and Mudejar styles, with the addition of Renaissance and Baroque elements in later alterations, in a work of astonishing beauty. For a long time its function has been that of a residence for the Royal Family, something that you will see reflected in the sumptuousness of its construction and interior decoration. It is the oldest royal palace in use in Europe. You can also enjoy one of the most famous scenes from Game of Thrones, the Palace of the Kingdom of Dorne. Inside you can admire the different rooms, the Lion's Gate, the Hall of Justice, the Moorish Courtyard, the Pool of Mercury, etc. Finally, let our guide guide you through the narrow streets and courtyards of the Barrio de Santa Cruz, the old Jewish guarter of Seville.





DESCRIPTION

Enjoy your visit to Seville in a different way. You will see the city on a 1 hour boat trip on the Guadalquivir River, where you can see the Torre del Oro, the Bullring, the old bridges, the Triana neighbourhood, the Expo '92 pavilions, the towers of the Plaza de España, etc. You will also be able to appreciate the diversity of buildings along the river bank and how the city has evolved, from 15th century buildings to the most modern ones, such as the Seville Tower, completed in 2015. The Guadalquivir River crosses the whole of Andalusia with its more than 700km length and connects the capital, Seville, with the Atlantic Ocean. In fact its current name derives from the Arabic "al-wadi al-kibir", which translates into our language as "big river". This is where the merchant ships docked in the port of Seville, loaded with gold, silver, tobacco and other valuable and much sought-after goods. In fact, it was at the Monastery of Santa Maria de las Cuevas, situated on a small island in the Guadalquivir known as the Isla de la Cartuja, that Christopher Columbus planned his voyage across the ocean in search of India.

DESCRIPTION

Discover Italica, the first Roman city of Hispania, on a 4-hour tour from Seville. Explore the city's ruins, theatre and amphitheatre. Italica is the first authentic Roman city in Spain, located 15 minutes from Seville, in the town of Santiponce. It was founded in 206 BC by the Roman general Publius Cornelius Scipio Africanus. The city was the birthplace of two Roman emperors: Trajan and Hadrian. Now called the Conjunto Arqueológico de Itálica, visitors today can enjoy walking through the ancient streets and exploring the ruins of the houses and public buildings. The main attraction is the amphitheatre, which had a capacity of 25,000 people, making it the third largest in the Roman Empire. Other places of interest are the mosaic pavements, Trajaneum, the sculptures of Diana, Venus and Trajan, the public baths and the Roman theatre partly reconstructed in Santiponce. Thanks to the fact that none of the following civilisations settled on the ruins of Italica it is a fairly well preserved city and well worth a visit. In this Roman city, precisely in its amphitheatre, part of the scenes of the seventh season of the famous series Game of Thrones were filmed. After this unforgettable experience we will cross Seville by bus, where you can see the most emblematic monuments of the city: the Triana Bridge, the Calle Betis, the Plaza de Toros and the Torre del Oro







Once in Ronda, how not to visit the region of the Sierra de Cádiz-Pueblos Blancos before our return to Seville. The origin of its name lies in the popular custom among the local inhabitants of whitewashing the outside of their houses and decorating them with brightly coloured potted flowers which combined with the golden sunshine, the mountain peaks, the green hills and blue sky creates a true explosion of colour. Here we find the Sierra de Grazalema, Andalusia's first natural park, one of the most ecologically outstanding in Spain. Famous for its spectacular limestone landscape, its steep cliffs, ravines, caves and its unique Spanish fir forest. We will make a stop in Zahara de la Sierra, the most spectacular town in the area because of its Arabic Torre del Homenaje, which overlooks part of the Sierra de Grazalema National Park, where this village stands, an obligatory stop on the route of the white villages of Cadiz. Its treasures include the church of Santa María de la Mesa and gañotes, almond and cinnamon sweets.



DESCRIPTION

After less than an hour's drive from Seville we will arrive at the Doñana National Park, one of the largest and most important wetland reserves in Europe, declared a Biosphere Reserve and inscribed on the World Heritage List. Once there, we will get into the 4x4 to visit the National Park. Doñana offers a great variety of natural ecosystems such as lagoons, marshes, fixed and mobile dunes, scrubland, Mediterranean forest and 30 km of unspoilt beaches. Medina Azahara is an important archaeological site located 8 km from Cordoba. It was home to more than 15,000 people, and was famous for its enormous luxury, careful planning and beautiful gardens. Finally, we will visit the famous Visitor Reception Centre, winner of the prestigious Aga Khan Award for architecture in 2009.

- **Nasrid Palaces:** where there are a large number of rooms, including the Mexuar, Comares and Los Leones Palaces, the latter considered to be the greatest exponent of Nasrid art.
- **Generalife:** summer palace, located to the east of the Alhambra and surrounded by extensive gardens brimming with the most varied vegetation, framed by an unmistakably Islamic landscape architecture. The order in which the different areas are visited will be determined by the time of entry to the Nasrid Palaces.
