SENSORY WINE TASTING

Let's learn how to taste Franciacorta wine by using the 5 senses:

with our eyes we can scan its colour and perlage, with our sense of smell we let ourselves be inundated by the scents and memories it evokes, with our taste we appreciate its aromas, with our touch we feel the perlage of the bubbles on our tongue, with our hears we hear the sound of the cork when the bottle is opened, the sound of the wine being poured in the glass and the sound of bubbles rising to the surface.

BLIND TASTING

It is dark all around. In the silence, only light footsteps and the sound of wine being poured can be heard. Then a hand guides my fingers towards the goblet. With a slow and somewhat uncertain gesture, I bring the glass closer to me and slowly feel the fear give way to curiosity. Tasting in the dark is a very special experience and initially destabilising because it is difficult to give up all the information that the appearance of the wine can provide. You have to let go of the reins of rationality and let yourself be carried away by instinct, forgetting the parameters of judgement to which we are accustomed when we approach wine.
