With its cool bars, ice-cream parlours, restaurants and elegant boutiques, the large and tree-lined avenues of the pedestrian area in the city centre are the ideal place to go window shopping or to have a walk through the street markets. The museums are conveniently located near the city centre and are waiting to be explored: the Red House (Casa Rossa), that is the former residence of the late writer Alfredo Panzini, the Saracen Tower (La Torre Saracena) that houses the Shell Museum (Museo delle conchiglie), the Museum of Radio History (Museo delle radio storiche), the Museum of Tourism and Traditions (Museo del turismo e delle tradizioni) are worth adding to your itinerary.

Bella for sport activities



The innovative sport facilities, a 25 hectare urban park and the hotels specialized in welcoming athletes make Bellaria Igea Marina the ideal destination not only for athletes of all ages, but even for those who want to organize training camps, meetings or events. The cycling enthusiasts can enjoy the cycling routes in the hinterland: the path along the banks of the river Uso could be taken as starting point. On the beach you can do some sport to keep fit even on holiday: beach volley, beach tennis, beach soccer, golf, Nordic Walking and marathon. If you prefer water sports you can go for sailing, windsurfing, diving and SUP courses.

The local cuisine is one of the most famous and appreciated in the world. The tasty piadina is well-known as the trademark of Romagna, but also the handmade pasta prepared by the so-called azdore (housewives), as well as the fish and seafood recipes are worth mentioning.
