## DAY 1 - SOUTHERN CHARM

(full-day tour)

10.00 Departure from your accommodation

Visit of the nature parc Las Salinas where for more than 2,700 years salt is quarried. We explore the salt ponds, the salt museum of Sant Francisco, the tower of Sa Sal Rossa, and 'Las Casetas Varadero'.

In Sa Caleta we will visit the excavation site of the first settlement of the Phoenicians and discover a secret tunnel. This is followed by the tasting of a Café Caleta (a local specialty). Then we continue to the Festival Club, where past and present meet followed by a lunch in a local restaurant in Es Cubells.

In the afternoon we drive to the Roc ES VEDRA shrouded in legend then visit 'Time and Space' a monument by Andrew Rogers. Afterward, we learn about the newest curiosities in the plant world in the Botanical Garden.

We continue to Sant Antoni where tradition and culture expect us in Sa Punta des Moll with its unique street art exhibited here by internationally famous artists

To round the day up we enjoy a magical unforgettable sun dawn with a glass of Sangria.

Return to your accommodation.

## DAY 2 - DISCOVERY OF THE ISLAND FORMENTERA

(day tour)

08.30 Departure from your accommodation to the Port of Ibiza, from where we will transpose with a ferry or catamaran to the neighbouring island.

During a leisurely stroll through the capital San Francisco Javier we discover unusual shops and a fortified church. Then we continue to the westernmost point of the island to Mola. After a short photo stop at the mirador from where a spectacular view allows the discovery of the entire island.

At the lighthouse of La Mola, one of the first in the Mediterranean Sea, you will marvel at the crystal-clear water, sparkling in all blue and turquoise shades, what Jules Verne described as 'A place to take the measure of the world'. We return to Pilar la Mola, from where we walk the ancient Roman road 'el cami de Sa Pujada' in direction Es Calo. During our walk, we stop at a winery to regain some strength with excellent local wine.

Our lunch will take place in a typical beach restaurant.

Afterward, we visit the megaliths of Ca Na Costa and enjoy the beach promenade of Es Pujols.

To close the day, we enjoy the breathtaking beach from Ses Iletes which lays in the Nature Parc of Las Salinas with an option of a sea bath.

The return for Ibiza is scheduled for late afternoon.

### DAY 3 - UNKNOWN IBIZA

(half-day tour)

09.30 Departure from your accommodation in direction Ibiza Town (half-day excursion – 4 hours)

You will walk on the traces of more than 2.700 years of history in the Old Town declared UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE in 1999.

We start from the port and enter the walled old town which we will ascend to the cathedral. You have an opportunity to purchase small refreshments in the convent San Cristobal or to try one of the specialties, baked by their nuns.

On our way through partly hidden old alleyways, your tour guide will tell you astonishing stories about the history of the island and its legends. Arrived at the top at the cathedral 'Santa Maria de las Nieves' you have a panoramic view over Ibiza town. During our descend we pass the old Dominican cloister on our walk down to the main gate the 'Portal de Ses Taules' from where we discover the local Marina.

Free time to stroll along and enjoy.

(Full day tour)



The lunch is scheduled in a restaurant with a special atmosphere at the beach of Cala Sant Vicente.

During the afternoon we drive towards Saint Ines where we are wandering through some still wild untouched nature leading to a mysterious fort of which the function is lost in the fog of time.
